- CDS-Cumberland reimburses providers for round-trip travel time from their home, office or another client's location, whichever is the shortest distance, effective July 1, 2001.
- Travel time must be billed separately from therapy time. The FY03 CDS bill provides a space for travel time.
- Travel time must be billed to the nearest 15-minute unit. Example: If your travel time takes 20 minutes, bill for 15 minutes. If your travel time takes 39 minutes, bill for 45 minutes. See above chart.
- Travel time is reimbursable for services that are on page 5 of the child's IFSP/IEP and evaluations. Travel time is not allowed for ECT, PET meetings, etc.
- Medicaid may not be billed for travel time; however, for a Medicaid-funded child, the therapist may bill CDS-Cumberland for travel time only.
- If a therapist travels to one location and sees more than one child at this location, only one request for reimbursement may be made for that trip.
- Travel time reimbursements must be billed by the end of the following month. **No travel time reimbursements beyond that time period will be paid.** For example, when billing for travel time for the month of July, your travel reimbursement bill must be in on or before August 31.
